The annual Richard Newell Memorial Fly-in Drive-in Breakfast at Piseco Airport on the last Saturday in August is a tradition started in 1975. This event drew over 900 people and 50 aircraft to the area in 2022. It serves as both a major community social event and a fund-raiser to help support those in need.



Speculator Lions are a major supporter of the "Summer Heat" fundraiser which provides heating assistance.

Recurring donations are made to several other charities and community service organizations.

Financial assistance is provided on a case-by-case basis to those facing financial hardship due to medical situations, fires, floods, or other emergencies.
